Title: <u>Blue Skies Texas (BST) Liaison; and Army Residence</u> Community (ARC) Liaison

Importance of Position: Volunteers are fundamental to the success of the MOAA-AC. This position acts as the focal point and liaison between the Alamo Chapter leadership/staff and the residents at the ARC, BST-East; and BST-West.

General Expectations:

- Must be a resident of the ARC; BST-East; or BST-West.
- Be a current member of National MOAA and of MOAA-AC.
- Attend 85%-100% of staff and membership meetings and events.

Position Qualifications:

- Excellent human relations skills.
- Ability to plan and organize.
- Not hesitant to ask individuals to join the Chapter and participate in Chapter events.
- Have a current driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Be on email.

Responsible to: Chapter President

Major Responsibilities:

- Promote the values of being a Chapter member to residents.
- Promote the Chapter at the ARC and BST-East & BST-West newcomer orientations.
- Be the point person for hosting a Chapter membership luncheon at the ARC and BST-East & BST-West.
- Publicize Chapter meetings and events to ARC and BST-East & BST-West residents.
- Actively solicit new Chapter members.
- Attend and participate in scheduled staff meetings and Chapter functions.

Training/Preparation: Meet with the President and key Chapter staff members to discuss duties, etc.

Average Time Commitment: 3-5 hours per month.

Length of Commitment: Minimum two years.

Measure of Success:

Active participation by a sizeable number of ARC and BST-East & BST-West residents in Chapter events.
