Legislative Report

The state legislator is taking a break after four special sessions called by Governor Abbott which had the primary purpose of passing legislation for school vouchers.

Some legislation was passed which helped implement property tax reforms passed in the November elections and some border legislation.

We are now waiting on the interim charges (i.e. directives for lawmakers to study certain issues in between legislative sessions) to be released to the various committees in preparation for the next session. We are in need of identifying members who would like to be part of a legislative team that will advocate with various representatives and state senators during the interim and when the next session begins. The governor and lieutenant governor were disappointed that the school vouchers did not pass the house, and they have indicated they will "primary" republican legislators in the House that opposed them.

Of much more importance, at this time, is federal legislation that must be passed to keep the federal government running. Attendant to that are several pieces of legislation that MOAA is supporting. We need Alamo Chapter members to immediately log on to MOAA.org, go to the Legislative Advocacy Center, look at the legislative campaigns and send letters to your senators and representatives in support of these.

As potential partial government shutdowns loom in the next several weeks, we are focused on the spending bills that fund the Department of Defense and the Department of Homeland Security and ensuring that our service members are paid. Also, we need to support the Richard Star Act that will benefit over 6500 combat veterans in the state of Texas.

As a reminder, when you access the MOAA website, you will need to select the identifier Alamo Chapter TX16 to associate you with our Chapter and show National that we are actively supporting legislation.

Lt. Gen. Brian T. Kelly, USAF (Ret), is a native of New Jersey. He earned his bachelor's degree in aerospace engineering from the University of Notre Dame and holds two master's degrees, one in national resource strategy from National Defense University and another in military operational arts and sciences from Air University.

Kelly joined the Air Force in 1989, as a graduate of Notre Dame's ROTC program. In his 33-year Air Force career, Kelly served in a number of key command and staff positions, including commander, 92nd Mission Support Squadron, Fairchild AFB, Wash.; deputy director, manpower and personnel, Multi-National Security Transition Command, Iraq; director, manpower, personnel and administration, U.S. Southern Command, Fla.; commander, 31st Mission Support Group, Aviano Air Base, Italy; commander, 501st Combat Support Wing, RAF Alconbury, U.K.; director, manpower, personnel and services, Air Combat Command, JB Langley-Eustis, Va.; director, military force management policy for deputy chief of staff for manpower, personnel and services at the Pentagon; and commander, Air Force Personnel Center, JB San Antonio-Randolph, Texas.

At the time of his service retirement in 2022, Kelly had completed 3½ years serving as the Air Force's deputy chief of staff for manpower, personnel and services at the Pentagon.

Kelly took over as MOAA's president and CEO in January 2023.

General Kelly will be our guest speaker at our sold out chapter luncheon on January 11th and will meet with the Chapter leadership team that afternoon.
