# Join MOAA's Surviving Spouse Virtual Chapter

MOAA's Surviving Spouse Virtual Chapter is an affinity group whose members share information and ideas with others in a virtual environment. After starting the virtual meetings through quarterly teleconferences, the Surviving Spouse Virtual Chapter now meets monthly through Zoom. Almost 40 states are represented in the membership. This chapter is intended to be an enhancement to, rather than take the place of, geographic chapters, and there are no dues.

Several weeks in advance of each meeting, members receive an email alerting them to the date and time of the gathering; a follow-on email with instructions for joining is sent several days prior to each meeting. The session is kept to an hour and a half and members can log on or off according to their schedule. Topics of discussion and presentations have included Survivor Benefit Plan-Dependency and Indemnity Compensation offset updates, financial information, and updates from MOAA national as well as other items of interest.

Members participate to the extent they are able. While the chapter is geared toward surviving spouses and surviving spouse liaisons, any MOAA spouse is welcome for membership. MOAA's mantra "Never Stop Serving" is espoused to make a difference locally, statewide, and nationally.

## Chapter Bylaw Amendments

The MOAA-AC Board of Directors amended the Chapter Bylaws dated November 21, 2019. These amended Bylaws will be presented to the membership for approval at the November 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting/Luncheon.

Here is a synopsis of the amendments:

**Art I. para C.** Added info about the Alamo Chapter Educational Foundation.

**Art I para D.** Changed mission words to match what are on the website.

Art II para H. Added "the".

**Art V para A.** Deleted "Redundant with C."

**Art VII para A.** Added the new VP titles/positions that were previously approved for by the Board.

**Art VII para E.** Added the new VP duties and responsibilities.

**Art VII para F.** Deleted Advertising Coordinator and Awards, and Scholarships Committee Chair since these are now the VP Marketing and Development and VP Scholarships and Leadership Development positions.

**Arts VIII and XIII**. Changed from "employee" to "staff" since we technically have no "employees" since Trish is an independent contractor.

**Art XI para A.** Cleaned up reference to the Foundation with its new acronym, i.e., "MACEF"

Page 11. Changed Board Chair signature block.

## Texas Special Constitutional Amendment Election November 7<sup>th</sup>

#### **Key dates to remember:**

- Oct. 10 is the last day to register to vote and submit an address change.
- Early voting starts Oct. 23 and goes through Nov. 3
- Oct. 27 is the last day to request a mail-in ballot.

#### What's on the ballot

Each item on the ballot was approved by the Texas Legislature earlier this year.

**Proposition 1** – HJR 126 "The constitutional amendment protecting the right to engage in farming, ranching, timber production, horticulture, and wildlife management." **Proposition 2** – SJR 64 "The constitutional amendment authorizing a local option exemption from ad valorem taxation by a county or municipality of all or part of the appraised value of real property used to operate a child-care facility."

**Proposition 3** – <u>HJR 132</u> "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the imposition of an individual wealth or net worth tax, including a tax on the difference between the assets and liabilities of an individual or family."

Proposition 4 – HJR 2 "The constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to establish a temporary limit on the maximum appraised value of real property other than a residence homestead for ad valorem tax purposes; to increase the amount of the exemption from ad valorem taxation by a school district applicable to residence homesteads from \$40,000 to \$100,000; to adjust the amount of the limitation on school district ad valorem taxes imposed on the residence homesteads of the elderly or disabled to reflect increases in certain exemption amounts; to except certain appropriations to pay for ad valorem tax relief from the constitutional limitation on the rate of growth of appropriations; and to authorize the legislature to provide for a four-year term of office for a member of the board of directors of certain appraisal districts."

**Proposition 5** – <u>HJR 3</u> "The constitutional amendment relating to the Texas University Fund, which provides funding to certain institutions of higher education to achieve national prominence as major research universities and drive the state economy."

**Proposition 6** –  $\underline{SJR}$  75 "The constitutional amendment creating the Texas water fund to assist in financing water projects in this state."

**Proposition 7** – <u>SJR 93</u> "The constitutional amendment providing for the creation of the Texas energy fund to support the construction, maintenance, modernization, and operation of electric generating facilities to ensure the reliability or adequacy of an electric power grid in the state. **Proposition 8** – <u>HJR 125</u> "The constitutional amendment creating the broadband infrastructure fund to expand highspeed broadband access and assist in the financing of connectivity projects."

**Proposition 9** – <u>HJR 2</u> "The constitutional amendment authorizing the 88th Legislature to provide a cost-of-living adjustment to certain annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas."

**Proposition 10** – <u>SJR 87</u> "The constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation equipment or inventory held by a manufacturer of medical or biomedical products to protect the Texas healthcare network and strengthen our medical supply chain."

**Proposition 11** –  $\underline{SJR\ 32}$  "The constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to permit conservation and reclamation districts in El Paso County to issue bonds supported by ad valorem taxes to fund the development and maintenance of parks and recreational facilities.

**Proposition 12** – <u>HJR 134</u> "The constitutional amendment providing for the abolition of the office of county treasurer in Galveston County."

**Proposition 13** – <u>HJR 107</u> "The constitutional amendment to increase the mandatory age of retirement for state justices and judges."

**Proposition 14** - <u>SJR 74</u> "The constitutional amendment providing for the creation of the centennial parks conservation fund to be used for the creation and improvement of state parks."

## **Transition Tips**

## After the Hire

While the hiring process may be viewed as an adventure or a challenge, it does have its stress. That can't be denied. Congrats. You've maneuvered your way through that process and have landed a job. You are now in a mix of emotions, excitement, and anxiety, especially if this is your first job in the "civilian' world.

You will find that this will be a whole new culture for you. You'll walk into the new job and won't have the uniform or any of the other trappings that helped you as you moved through your military career. Not to worry. We've been there and survived/thrived.

The first day will be frenetic as you complete the new hire paperwork, meet so many folks, and get a feel for the surroundings. Some places use nametags so that will help with the name game. When I was a director of HR, I would always stress to the welcoming manager the need for a mentor to bring any new employee on board. Hopefully, your company HR has the same position. This person can help you go through the first days and weeks to a quick assimilation into the company and the job.

My suggestion is that you also take charge of your integration into the company. So many companies have created resource groups. These are employees with similar interests or backgrounds that meet regularly. Sometimes the purpose is social. Other times, these folks gather for a common interest such as community volunteerism and outreach. Others may have a similar hobby or sport activity.

The purpose of these groups is to promote employee camaraderie. And you thought this was only in the military. The opportunity for new folks is to create friendships and also support systems for each other, those who are new and those who have been there a while. I recommend that you put this on your list of things to do as you start a new job. The military is not the only organization that thrives on teams. The quicker and more smoothly that you assimilate into a new company, the greater the path to success.
