VP Membership: COL Felix Santiago, USA (Ret) – Current chart shows 346 Active Duty, 169 Surviving Spouse, 57 Former and 830 Retired giving a total of 1402 members. This is a net loss of 22 from last month, mainly Active Duty. The number of dues paying members currently stands at 582 or 42%. According to MOAA models their goal is 65% of paying members, and if we factor in that we only retain 10% of the active duty our dues paying is nearer 64.5%.

Felix is monitoring the deletions and sending personal emails to the retired members. Will submit an article to the Lariat reminding all to update their emails addresses with us in the event of a change and also to include a date of birth, even if it just the year so as to take advantage of the 90+ lifer no dues required status. Has been researching the deceased members and noted a significant lag time in reporting. It is labor intensive and involves many data sources.

VP Programs: Col David Patrick, USAF (Ret) – January program featuring Kenny Wilson from Haven For Hope was fantastic. February's is with Shane Ostrom talking about Medicare and Social Security, March is the Scholarship Awards from 2-3pm. In case the June Dinner Dance has to be cancelled Laura Koerner from the Texas Veterans Commission will be invited.

VP Legislative Affairs: Maj Jim Cunningham, USA (Ret) – Nationally – the MOAA Storming of the Hill has been renamed Advocacy in Action and it will be virtual. The three main areas of focus will be toxic exposure, TriCare for young adults and basic needs for military families.

The Texas State legislature has a new speaker of the House, Dade Phelan, though none of the Committees have chairs. Numerous bills affecting veterans have been filed but procedures have yet to be put in place on how to conduct hearings.

President: LtCol Kitty Meyers, USAF (Ret) – Attended the first meeting of the TVC's Veteran Services Advisory Committee along with Jim Cunningham. Appears to be more than previous committees.

The chapter is looking for a Treasurer and a deputy Zoom master for when Jim is sidelined due to surgery. Contact Kitty with any suitable candidates. David Patrick also advised other positions need back ups too and that the Buddy Program should be re-emphasized. Kitty also reminded everyone that there will be elections this year, and a succession plan in place for five years now still has no President Elect.

Kitty is host "Kitty's Corner", a career training program in Onward to Opportunity (O2O) to answer questions on transition during a 3-day orientation provided by the University of Syracuse's Institute For Veterans and Military Families and underwritten by the Howard Schultz Foundation.

Active Duty Liaison Officer: Rachel Johnson, LT, USCG - Absent - no report.

Scholarship/JROTC: Col Peter Hunt, USAF (Ret) – The medal and certificate packages are ready for mailing. The database has been updated.

Applications received so far consist of 8 JROTC but none for chapter members. If still none by the deadline he proposes a "last chance" email be sent out.

Special Activities Representative: Susie Tolman, Surviving Spouse – Absent. No report.

Blue Skies of Texas Satellite Chapter Representative: LtCol Jim Conner, USAF (Ret) - 98% of the BST residents have received their 2^{nd} vaccinations, but it may be a few more weeks before the dining areas are opened, and meetings allowed.
