MOAA National Update:

Gave short presentation of the chapter's \$9000 availability in scholarships and it was warmly received. Names chosen by the commanders will be provided by Friday. Award ceremony dates still to be determined and presenters will be needed to award the Gold Bars.

David Patrick reminded all that the \$300 USAA/MOAA grant was requested to offset the cost of the scholarship recipients and their guests lunch costs, and Jim Cunningham will also request \$250 from TCC for hosting the meeting on their behalf in January.

Transition Liaison Officer: LtCol Kitty Meyers – Working on Mar 16th Job Fair, 10am-2pm. So far have 48 vendors for the Veterans Village and 82 employers signed up. The website MilCityUSA.org is becoming the go to site. Other activities include meeting with Roland Keller and SA Chamber on the 21st to discuss focus groups for disabled veterans, and TVC Women's Program on Mar 24-6 at the VFW.

David Patrick mentioned that activities for transitioning veterans was become saturated. To that end MOAA might want to rethink its annual presentation "Marketing Yourself for a Second Career", and another recommendation for a spouse's symposium!
