VP Membership: COL Felix Santiago, USA (Ret) – Current chart shows 319 Active Duty, 165 Surviving Spouse, 58 Former and 835 Retired giving a total of 1377. Net loss of 25 members. This is actually made up of a loss of 27 Active Duty and 4 Surviving Spouses, a gain of one former and 5 retired. Attrition rate for this is at 1.6%, but typically for us it is around 2%. Dues paying member increased by 7, and overall, the % of dues paying members is 50%. And with 10% attrition of Active Duty it computes to nearer 65%. In terms of non paying members it is 14% for the Lifer/Over 90, and potential payers total nearly 500 folks that we have

integrated in the past year. There have been approximately 60 deletions, 14 retired, 4 Surviving Spouses, with the remaining Active Duty. For this month I have already contacted the 13 folks on the To Be Deleted list, and the list in Appendix A are those that will be receiving the Final Email before going on the To Be Deleted list. Please review the listing in Appendix A list with 21 retirees, and if you know anyone, particularly the retirees, please communicate with them. 8 of them live in the ARC and/or Blue Skies. Will contact Jim Connor and Joe & Janet Morgan to request their assistance. David recommended this list be part of Felix's report and be moved from the Appendix and placed next to the Membership Chart going forward.

Kitty advised the Levels of Excellence Award contains a criteria that measures the number of chapter members who are moaa national members.

VP Programs: Col David Patrick, USAF (Ret) – February program featuring Shane Ostrom from MOAA was well received. Next month's virtual Scholarship Awards even will be in the afternoon from 2-3:30pm with MajGen Leavitt. In October we hope to resume in person events and MOAA's Dan Merry has been invited to speak at Blue Skies. Chapter events will remain virtual through June and will be reevaluated at that time.

VP Legislative Affairs: Maj Jim Cunningham, USA (Ret) – Very quiet on the legislative front. The state's first senate meeting was held yesterday but no bills were discussed, just mainly topics of organization. The House had their first meeting on the 8th and only one bill regarding veterans was discussed - college credits for military experience.

Testimony for both House and Senate will be on an invitation only basis and we will need to stay in constant contact with the committee chairs otherwise it will be virtual.

At the federal level MOAA has three main priorities. The Texas Council of Chapter has been asked to organize virtual meetings with Texas representatives for Advocacy in Action and Larry Petrash will be coordinating it. The quarterly meeting of the Texas Council of Chapters will be on Saturday Mar 6.

Since Monday, Lackland and BAMC are vaccinating those folks 65 and older at their designated facilities.

President: LtCol Kitty Meyers, USAF (Ret) – Will be attending (hosting) the TCC zoom meeting, and Health Protocol conditions at JBSA San Antonio are currently Bravo Plus.

Also is still very involved in Military Spouse virtual programs.

Scholarship/JROTC: Col Peter Hunt, USAF (Ret) – Will be pre-briefing MajGen Leavitt via zoom on March 22 and information on the scholarship winners has been assembled. Will be sending out at least 3 RSVP reminders to the winners for their one-minute introductions. Chapter Member, Col John Duncan, on General Leavitt's staff, is also on the Scholarship Committee and has signed up to be a Buddy for this program and will shadow Pete for next year.

Blue Skies of Texas Satellite Chapter Representative: LtCol Jim Conner, USAF (Ret) – Absent. No report.
