Executive VP Operations: LTC Bill Goforth – Absent. No report.

Vice President Administration: Jim Webb – All schools have been contacted regarding JROTC award availability, medals are on back order at MOAA but have enough for now. Currently support 130 JROTC units. Jim will coordinate the Army and Peter to coordinate the Air Force, Navy and Marine JROTC's. Using Dropbox to store the document. Working with Jerry Gonzales, Volunteer Coordinator, and using the database of members sorted by zip provided by Trish to recruit presenters for the award ceremonies.

VP Membership: LTC Randy Hoff – Absent. Reviewed the Membership chart: Active Duty 396, Auxiliary 197, Former 30, Retired 842 for a total of 1462 members. Received a check for \$5,015 from MOAA national for last year's recruitment incentives.

VP Programs: (Open) – March Mayoral panel has received green light from JBSA. So far 6 candidates have confirmed their participation, and the moderator will be from the Express News. The subject of the panel will be what the Mayor will do for the military community and how the city will be involved. Still working on speaker for April at Blue Skies. Kerry Green suggested ROTC brigade commander for Scholarship luncheon in May.

President: Maj Jim Cunningham – Recently drove to Wichita Falls chapter to speak on military legislation, and returned via Austin to participate in Advocating on the Hill on Feb 25-26. Assisting TVCO to be set up as a non-profit and creating by laws etc. Busy with March 19 Job Fair, response has exceeded last year's Fair. Continues to be involved in the San Antonio Chamber and the Military Affairs Committee. Submission to JBSA has been made nominating LTC Jim Webb as the chapter's Volunteer of the Year – congrats Jim! From legislative meetings in Austin it is clear there is a great need for education about the military to the new Chair of the VAMI committee, but fortunately the Attorney General and the new governor are pro military.
