VP Legislative Affairs: LTC Robert Blake, USA (Ret) – Bob Blake will encourage the Aspirational Goal Committee to visit congress members during summer recess.

Jim Cunningham advised the Texas Coalition of Veterans Organizations is requesting everyone contact the Veterans Affairs Committee regarding SB1091 which aims to restrict the number of license plates that qualify for toll discounts and will restrict to one per household. Jim will send emails to the staff regarding who to contact before the Monday vote. The occurrence of a special session this year will depend on the progress of the Ad Valorem tax bill and the Education bill. Concerning is the proposed reduction of 17,000 military medical personnel and the expectation that civilian medical offices will be able to cover it. Be aware that a civilian doctor can refer you to a military specialist.

President: LtCol Kitty Meyers, USAF (Ret) – Presenting awards at Army and AF ROTC Awards ceremonies in Austin, heavily involved in the SA Chamber's Military Affairs Committee and the Senior Enlisted Advisory panel on Ft Sam. Col Mary Garr is chairing CAM Week activities and Kitty has joined that committee. Working on Red, White & You Job Fair on November 7th and commemoration of the 71st anniversary of Women in the Military Act on June 12. Will provide info for The Lariat and for distribution to the ARC and Blue Skies. A museum for Army Vietnam Vets is being constructed at the corner of 1604 & NW Military in the headquarters of Lynd Construction – opening ceremony sometime in October which will include the travelling Vietnam Memorial Wall.
